POWELL FOUNDATION 2013 GRANT GUIDELINES

GRANTS CRITERIA

The Powell Foundation will support nonprofit organizations with the potential to achieve high impact within the arts, education, conservation and health sectors. The Foundation looks for innovators in their respective fields and supports organizations with strong board and administrative leadership that have the capacity to conduct meaningful and effective work. The Foundation practices transparency and expects that of its grant recipients. A strong balance sheet and broad financial support as well as a record of successful outcomes are all essential for consideration. Additionally, organizations are assessed on their planning capabilities and ability to leverage their strengths with other community organizations.

ELIGIBILITY

- ❖The requesting organization must be tax-exempt.
- ❖Each request must be in writing and should be accompanied by the Foundation's proposal summary form, governance questionnaire, tax exempt affirmation form and the required list of attachments.
- The Powell Foundation's Directors must be persuaded that the requesting organization engages in sound financial planning and solid management practices. The Foundation reserves the right at any time to request information on the destination of funds granted.
- Normally, the Foundation will not consider requests for building funds or grant commitments extending into successive calendar years.
- *The Foundation Directors are interested principally in grants to be spent in the Foundation's geographic areas of interest, i.e., Harris, Travis, or Walker Counties, Texas.
- *Special consideration will be given to those requests addressing critical and/or basic needs and/or having timing of the essence.

The Foundation does not expect to support:

- ❖Grants to religious organizations for religious purposes.
- *Fund raising events or advertising.
- ❖Grants to other private foundations.
- ❖Grants to cover past operating deficits or debt retirement.
- ❖Grants for support to individuals.
- ❖ The Powell Foundation operates on a calendar year and its Board meets twice a year in the spring and in the fall. Deadlines are not set due to staff capacity. To allow for optimum consideration and due diligence, submission of proposals is required at least two months prior to a board meeting for consideration. Those seeking funds are encouraged to apply to the Foundation at their own discretion. Grants that do not make the internal deadline for one meeting will be considered for the next meeting.

The Board of Directors has the responsibility for final approval of each grant. Since the Foundation receives funding requests far in excess of its funds available for grants, only a small portion of the requests received can be approved. A decision not to fund a request does not reflect on the merits of the applicant or the value of its request, but rather results from limited resources.

If your organization is classified as a 509 (a) (3) Supporting Organization we need to know what type you are: Type I, Type II or Type III with an explanation indicating why you are classified as such.
- A current list of your organization's Board of Directors.
- A list of the previous and present year's foundation, corporate and large individual funders including project, date and amount awarded.
- A copy of your current operating budget along with your organization's purpose and a summary of your activities.
- A copy of the line item budget of the specific, proposed program/project requested, if applicable.
- A list of community partners (excluding funders and in-kind donors) for your organization & specific program/project requested.
- A list of <u>up to six</u> measurable goals and targets to determine the impact of your organization, program or project during the period for which grant funds are requested to assist with evaluation.
- It is preferred that videos or large brochures <u>not</u> be submitted with proposals.
