The main services that were provided were free hunting and fishing trips. The 2013 direct support to clients = \$36,304. 2) Support to Schools and Other Charitable Organizations: During 2013, The P.A.T.H. Foundation supported several schools and charitable organizations with programs that focused on outdoor heritage opportunities for the youth and disadvantaged individuals such as kid's fishing day events, archery in school programs, youth skeet teams, shooting activities, and other activities.
