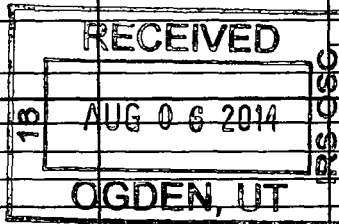

(a) A \$2,000.00 scholarship (gift) will be awarded for the recipient's freshman year in a four year college or university with funding to be provided in the amount of \$1,000.00 per semester upon evidence of enrollment in a college or university of the recipient's choice. Currently there is only one category of scholarship benefit with recipients being limited to graduating seniors of Covington High School, Covington, Louisiana; however, if funding is available additional scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors of other high schools in the State of Louisiana (particularly Tara High School, Baton Rouge, Louisiana). The recipients are to be selected from a group of five (5) nominees named by the senior class advisor and the assistant principal responsible for academics at Covington High School (or other respective high schools). The foundation trustee will select the recipient from among the five (5) nominees based upon merit. To be nominated, a student should:
- 1) be a graduating senior, 2) who has excelled in a college preparatory curriculum with a strong emphasis in science and math,
  - 3) who plans to attend a four year college or university and major in the field of science or secondary education, 4) who has a high overall grade point average, 5) who has demonstrated leadership ability and 6) who has participated in extracurricular activities.
- Nominees desiring to be considered shall submit to the selection committee (trustees of The Boyd Foundation Charitable Trust) a resume, transcript, background information and a short essay on why the nominee should be selected.
- (b) A second scholarship of \$2,000 (gift) will be awarded to a graduating senior who will major in Agriculture or a related field. All of the other conditions stated above apply to this second scholarship.




