Explanation: Education programs include grants to support exceptional K-12 teachers, grants to provide scholarships to first generation underserved university students, and grants and endowments for graduate programs, particularly in law. The Foundation supports a number of universities, with special emphasis on Lamar University here in Beaumont. One program is, unlike those previously described, uncoventional. This program is the legislative internship program, which takes students from multiple universities and provides them a semester at the Texas Legislature. The Beaumont Foundation is closely

monitoring this program.

Special attention has been given to children through Kids Cafe and Backpack programs and to the rural poor through Rural Pantry programs. The remaining grants in this area are fund awards for emergency care for at risk populations served by churches.
