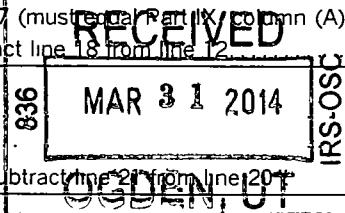

The following sections are provided to facilitate your review and the preparation of your tax return.

The 2013 Proceeds from Broker and Barter Exchange Transactions section includes both sales of positions for "covered securities" and "noncovered securities." A covered security includes those with a purchase date within the following timeline: Equities acquired on or after January 1, 2011 and Mutual Funds acquired on or after January 1, 2012. Legislation requires reporting the gross proceeds of the sales of "covered" and "noncovered" securities and the adjusted cost basis for "covered securities." Any sale of a security that is considered a "noncovered security" will still be included in this section with the adjusted cost basis (where available) but the adjusted basis will not be transmitted to the IRS.

In calculating gain (loss), unless otherwise noted, it was assumed that the oldest position was liquidated first, and that you have made an election to amortize the premium paid on the purchase of taxable bonds. Under the Cost Basis Reporting Regulations, brokers need not track wash sale activity for substantially identical securities, transactions across accounts, or between covered and non covered securities. However, you as a taxpayer still have to track and report wash sales as you have in the past which would include all of the aforementioned transaction types. In making adjustments to the cost basis of the purchase contract, it was assumed that the unit holder included contract adjustment payments in income when received.
