AT THE END OF 2013, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF COMPUTERS THE ORGANIZATION HAD SERVING IT MEMBERS IN THE CODY SCHOOL SYSTEM WAS APPROXIMATELY 10. AS OF 12/31/13, APPROXIMATELY 95% OF CODY'S ELEMENTARY STUDENTS, APPROXIMATELY 93% OF CODY'S MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS, AND APPROXIMATELY 80% OF CODY'S HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WERE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION. THE ORGANIZATION SUPPORTS THE "LIFE OF AN ATHLETE" AND THE "PURE PERFORMANCE" PROGRAMS, WHICH PROVIDE EDUCATION AND ENCOURAGEMENT REGARDING HEALTHY LIFESTYLE AND LIVING CHOICES. THE ORGANIZATION RECEIVES, RENT-FREE, SPACE FOR ITS FACILITIES FROM THE CODY SCHOOLS WHERE ITS COMPUTERS AND OTHER ASSETS ARE LOCATED AND USED BY THE ORGANIZATION'S MEMBERS AND BY SCHOOL DISTRICT TEACHERS AND STUDENTS. THE VALUE OF THIS DONATED SPACE IS UNKNOWN. THE ORGANIZATION, THROUGH ITS NEWSLETTER, PROVIDES DRUG EDUCATION INFORMATION TO MEMBERS' PARENTS. THE ORGANIZATION SPONSORED SPEAKERS WHO SPOKE TO CODY STUDENTS AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS REGARDING THE IMPORTANCE OF MAKING HEALTHY LIFESTYLE CHOICES AND SENT STAFF TO A TRAINING WORKSHOP. THE ORGANIZATION ORGANIZED AND CONDUCTED A SOCIAL EVENT EACH MONTH AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL. THE ORGANIZATION ASSISTS OTHER COMMUNITIES IN ESTABLISHING AND RUNNING THEIR OWN SIMILAR PROGRAMS. PURSUANT TO THE PREVENTION NEEDS ASSESSMENT AND THE YOUTH RISK ASSESSMENT, THE FREQUENT ILLEGAL DRUG AND ALCOHOL USE RATES BY YOUTH IN CODY IS ABOUT HALF THE NATIONAL AVERAGE RATE AND MUCH LOWER THAN OTHER WYOMING COMMUNITIES.
