Limited resources preclude consideration of funding for wildlife rehabilitation centers, zoos, recycling programs, tree planting projects, toxic waste cleanup, film productions, and fellowships.

 - the project's goals and objectives, including specific results to be achieved

- 3. The organization's projected annual budget, including a detailed project budget. (Please note that if your annual budget is over \$1 million, you are unlikely to receive funding from Maki Foundation.)
