#### **Amount and Disbursement of Scholarship**

The scholarship awarded by the Peñasco Valley Telephone Education Foundation Trust will be for \$4000 (\$500 per semester) for **undergraduate work only**. Once the Education Foundation receives proof of enrollment, \$500 of the scholarship will be made available prior to the beginning of the first semester.

The recipient is responsible for having written verification of their intent to attend the college/university/trade school in the PVT office two (2) weeks before the beginning of the school term. No monies will be issued without this verification.

Each consecutive semester thereafter, the student must present to the Education Foundation a grade report produced by the school certifying that the student carried at least 12 hours for the entire semester with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 for that semester. Upon receipt of this information and proof of future enrollment as a full time student, the Education Foundation will issue a payment of \$500 to the student. The maximum scholarship amount any student may receive is limited to a total of \$4000.
