

C.A.R.E. UTILITY ASSISTANCE GUIDELINES

PURPOSE:

The purpose shall be to assist in heating energy needs, with such assistance to be particularly for the purpose of helping to avoid termination of electric services and/or the failure of delivery of other energy sources. When such termination or failure of deliver would or could result in hardship or be a danger or threat to comfort, health or life.

ADMINISTRATION:

The Mt. Wheeler C.A.R.E. Board will administer this program.

The C.A.R.E. Board will make eligibility determination and season dates.

ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS:

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: To assist in an emergency situation to avoid termination of utility services.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Assistance can only be given to applicants that have met the following guidelines:

1. Completed application submitted by subscriber of utility service.
2. All requested documentation has been submitted.
3. Need for emergency assistance. A disconnect notice or failure to deliver other energy sources.
4. All other resource programs have been exhausted.
5. C.A.R.E. has not been issued in the last 12 months.
6. Military Service personnel active service and up to 90 days after return from active service. (Available entire 12 months of a calendar year)

PROCESS FOR APPROVAL/DENIAL OF APPLICANTS:

There are income guidelines for this program. A need for an emergency one-time assistance must be present. All guidelines established are consistent with those of White Pine County Social Services.

The C.A.R.E. program will not pay for utility reconnect fees.

After all of the eligibility criteria have been met and depending on the circumstances, the designated representative can authorize a payment of no more than \$400.00.

An assistance payment can only be authorized once in a twelve-month period. Extenuating circumstances or a life/death situation can be approved more than once in a twelve month period with approval from the C.A.R.E. Board and all supporting documentation for this type of situation has been submitted.
