Part III. Statement of Program Service Accomplishment. Answer to what the organization's primary exempt purpose is: The purpose of the Coast Range Association is to protect the coast range region's forest and related ecosystems from unwise use while fostering a new vision of stewardship, diversity and long term sustainability. The purposes of the corporation are accomplished through public education, research, and the advocacy of environmentally sound public policy toward the goal of building just and sustainable human communities that provide for people and the natural world. The corporation's purpose and mission is accomplished through three specific programs: 1. Conservation advocacy for terrestrial, freshwater, and marine biodiversity conservation, 2. Public lands management for native forest and aquatic (i.e. streams, rivers and their associated environments) conservation values of clean water and native salmon, and 3. public interest forest management through community forest initiatives. Specific description of achievements in carrying out the corporation's purpose for 990EZ, Part III 28, 29, 30 are below: Line 28. Conservation advocacy for terrestrial, freshwater, and marine biodiversity conservation. We transitioned our work on nearshore marine reserves toward a focus supporting the state of Oregon's implementation of three new marine reserves. This effort involved building new relationships with coastal conservation colleagues and community members for reserve implementation. Line 29. Public lands management for native forests and aquatic values. This program was our major effort for the year. We contracted aquatic scientist Dr. Chris Frissell to work on policy issues of the Northwest Forest Plan's -Aquatic Conservation Strategy (ACS). In May Dr. Frissell authored on our behalf "Evaluating Proposed Reductions of Riparian Reserve Protection in the Northwest Forest Plan: Potential Consequences for Clean Water, Streams and Fish". Over the next six months Dr. Frissell worked to organize an aquatic science review panel to assess new science related to the ACS. On December 2nd and 3rd a ten member panel met to evaluate the ACS in light of new science. The outcome was a detailed set of notes to be used for a major ACS related science paper in 2014. Line 30. Public interest forest management for watershed restoration and economic benefits was continued in 2013. From January through March, the CRA provided staff support to the Oregon Coast Community Forest Association (OCCFA) The The OCCFA is a 501c3 tax exempt organization seeking to own and manage forest lands for a public benefit and provide value added wood products for local communities.
