Eligibility / Program Description

The Pfaffinger Foundation makes a limited number of grants to social service organizations in the greater Los Angeles area with 501(c)3 tax-exempt status and audited financial statements. The Foundation supports agencies whose programs promote self-sufficiency among the working poor population, with a preference for programs utilizing case management. Grants are also made in areas related to the needs of Pfaffinger Foundation's individual clients, such as midcareer job retraining, services for seniors, and credit counseling.

The Foundation does not provide grants for services to the homeless, for substance abuse treatment, educational institutions, or most medical and mental health programs.

Grants will be provided for specific programs, special projects, and unrestricted operating support but only rarely for capital programs. Grants are typically within the range of \$5,000 to \$20,000. The Foundation will consider renewal funding and is sometimes able to invest in grantees and their programs over a period of years, although approvals are typically made annually.

Grant Applications

- The Foundation requests a letter of not more than three pages describing the organization and the uses to which the requested funds will be put.
- A Grant Summary Form, available from the Foundation, is to be included. It requests such
 additional information as recent audited financial statements, a current budget, sources of
 other income, proof of tax exempt status, and a listing of the board of directors.

<u>Program effectiveness.</u> Every proposal should specifically address the criteria by which the effectiveness of the program(s) supported by the grant will be measured, how this data will be used in the organization and how and when it will be communicated to the Foundation.

<u>Organizational effectiveness.</u> In addition to evaluating program effectiveness, the foundation will also consider the following additional criteria:

- 1) whether the organization has formalized strategic planning and/or budget review processes,
- 2) whether a formalized process is used for evaluating the senior managers of the organization,
- 3) whether measures have been adopted to assess the effectiveness of the board of directors and to communicate this to the board, and

Applying for a Grant (continued)

4) whether the organization's fund-raising and administrative costs seem proportionate to its total budget

The above four factors will be weighted more heavily in requests for unrestricted support.

Grant Review Schedule

Applications are normally considered at the September and December meetings of the Foundation's Board of Directors each year. For 2014, the periods for submission are:

- September meeting: April 1 June 16, 2014
- December meeting: June 15 -- September 15, 2014

Completed hard-copy applications must be date stamped in our office no later than June 14th and September 16th. Following receipt of a proposal, the Foundation may request additional information and in some cases schedule a site visit.

Notification

Applicants whose proposals are considered during the first round of grant making will be notified prior to the end of September 2014, and those considered in the second round, prior to the end of December 2014. Because funding is limited, some worthwhile proposals must be declined after initial reviews by staff or by a Board committee.
