ACTIVITIES NOT PREVIOUSLY REPORTED TO THE IRS

THE FOUNDATION IS REPORTING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN ITS ACTIVITIES. DURING 2013 THE FOUNDATION CONDUCTED FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES.

THE DONOR AND FOUNDER OF THE FOUNDATION, BANK OF HAWAII, ANNUALLY CONDUCT AN EMPLOYEE GIVING CAMPAIGN TITLED LIVEKOKUA CAMPAIGN. THE PROCEEDS FROM THIS CAMPAIGN ARE DONATED TO THE FOUNDATION. DURING 2013 THE BANK OF HAWAII EMPLOYEES MADE CASH AND NON-CASH DONATIONS. THESE NON-CASH ITEMS AND A MINIMAL AMOUNT OF THE CASH DONATIONS WERE USED TO CONDUCT A FUNDRAISING AUCTION. ADDITIONALLY, THE FOUNDATION SOLD 'DRESS-DOWN' STICKERS WHERE PURCHASERS (EMPLOYEES OF BANK OF HAWAII) COULD DRESS IN CASUAL DRESS ON SELECTED DATES. THESE FUNDS (PROCEEDS FROM THE AUCTION

AND DRESS-DOWN STICKER SALES) WERE REDISTRIBUTED TO ELIGIBLE CHARITIES AS DESCRIBED IN IRC SECTION 170(C) AND 509(A) PURSUANT TO THE FOUNDATION'S CHARITABLE PURPOSE. THE PROCEEDS OF THE FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES TOTALED \$71,802.78.

BECAUSE OF THE SUCCESS OF THE AUCTION AND 'DRESS-DOWN' STICKERS AS WELL AS THE VALUE OF THE PROCEEDS IN THE COMMUNITY, THE FOUNDATION PLANS TO CONTINUE THESE ACTIVITIES ANNUALLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE LIVEKOKUA CAMPAIGN.
