



- (c) The school makes its racially non-discriminatory policy known to all segments of the general community served by the school;
- (d) The school is able to demonstrate that all of its programs and facilities are operated in a racially non-discriminatory manner.
- (e) The school offers scholarship or other comparable benefits on a racially non-discriminatory basis;
- (f) The school does not racially discriminate in employment of faculty and administrative staff.


