Patient Support and Care For Kids Funds - Caring for someone with ALS is expensive and the financial impact on a family is usually two-fold. As the ALS progresses, the family will likely lose that person's income and others in the home may have to quit their job(s) to provide care. In the later stages of the disease, people require power wheelchairs, hospital beds, respiratory equipment, and professional 24 hour care and costs can easily exceed \$200,000 per year. This situation leaves many children with a parent suffering from ALS without any resources to enjoy simple childhood experiences such as summer camp, music lessons or playing team sports. The Golden West Chapter provides "scholarships" so that children may have these types of experiences. Each scholarship is \$300 and is limited to two scholarships per household.
