	stoves for their families. Women's teams are being organized and trained to install and maintain stoves.
	Photo voltaic systems for light are being introduced to eliminate kerosene burning as the primary light source in the Maasai homes.
	Ways to help the Maasai spread these benefits to many villages are being developed.
