BYLAWS OF KOCH FOUNDATION, INC.

(A Non-profit Corporation)

ARTICLE I

Name and Office

- Section 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is KOCH FOUNDATION, INC.
- Section 2. Office. The principal office of the Corporation shall be at 4421 NW $39^{\rm tr}$ Avenue, Building 1, Suite 1, Gainesville, Florida 32606. The Corporation may also have offices at such other places as the Board of Directors may from time to time appoint or the purposes of the Corporation may require Sep~23~2003?
- Section 3. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall commence on April 1 of each year and end on March 31, except for the first year, which shall commence on February 2, 1379. Jul 12 1979?

ARTICLE II

Membership

- Section 1. <u>Membership</u>. The membership of the Corporation shall consist of the Board of Directors, which shall have the power to designate its own successors.
- Section 2. <u>Membership Rights</u>. The right of a member to vote and all his right, title and interest in and to the Corporation shall cease on the termination of his membership. No member shall be entitled to share in the distribution of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation.
- Section 3. Resignation of Members. Any member may resign from the Corporation by delivering a written resignation to the President or Secretary of the Corporation, and his membership shall automatically terminate at such time as he ceases to serve as a director.
- Section 4. Annual Meetings. An annual meeting of the members of the Corporation shall be held each year on a date and at a time established by the Chairman of the Board or, if the Chairman fails to establish a date and time for a meeting as may be determined by any two 12 members of the Corporation. Notice of the meeting shall be given to each member in the manner provided by Section 5 of this Article II. The purpose for the annual meeting shall be to elect directors and for the transaction of such business as may properly come before the meeting. February 23 1991

Section 5. Notice of Annual Meetings. Notice of the time, place, and purpose or purposes of the annual meeting shall be served, either. personally or by mail, not less than ten (10) nor more than forty (40) days before the meeting upon each person who appears upon the books of the Corporation as a member and, if mailed, such notice shall be directed to the member at his address as it appears on the books of the Corporation, unless he shall have filed with the Secretary of the Corporation a written request that notices intended for him be mailed to some other address, in which case it shall be mailed to the address designated in such request.

Section 6. <u>Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings of the members, other than those regulated by statute, may be called at any time by the president or Vice President or by two directors and must be called by the president or Secretary on receipt of the written request of one-third of the members of the Corporation.

Section 7. Notice of Special Meetings. Notice of a special meeting stating the time, place and purpose or purposes thereof shall be served personally or by mail upon each member, not less than ten (10) nor more than sixty (60) days before such meeting and, if mailed, such notice shall be directed to each member at his address as it appears on the pooks or records of the Corporation, unless he shall have filed with the Secretary of the Corporation a written request that notices intended for him shall be mailed to some other address, in which case it shall be mailed to the address designated in such request. February 26 1980

Section 8. Quorum. At any meeting of members of the Corporation the presence of one-third (1/3) of the members in person or by proxy shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for all purposes except as otherwise provided by law, and the act of a majority of the members present at any meeting at which there is a quorum shall be the act of the full membership except as may be otherwise specifically provided by statute or by these ByLaws. In the absence of a quorum, or when a quorum is present, a meeting may be adjourned from time to time by vote of a majority of the members present in person or by proxy, without notice other than by announcement at the meeting and without further notice to any absent member. At any adjourned meeting at which a quorum shall be present, any business may be transacted which might have been transacted at the meeting as originally notified.

Section 9. <u>Voting</u>. Each member shall be entitled to vote in person, or by proxy duly appointed by instrument in writing which is subscribed by such member and which bears a date not more than eleven (11) months prior to such a meeting, unless such instrument provides a longer period. Each member of the Corporation shall be entitled to one (1) vote. All elections shall be had and all questions decided by a majority vote of the persons present in person or by proxy.

Section 10. <u>Waiver of Notice</u>. Whenever under the provisions of any law or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation or ByLaws of the Corporation, the Corporation or the Board of Directors or any committee thereof is authorized to take any action after notice to the members of the Corporation or after the lapse of a prescribed period of time, such action may be taken without notice and without the lapse of any period of time, if any time before or after such action is completed, such requirements are waived in writing by the person or persons entitled to such notice or entitled to participate in the action to be taken or by his authorized attorney.

Section 11. Removal of members, Directors or Officers. Any member or director may be removed from membership by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the full membership, registered either in person or by proxy, at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose. Any member or director proposed to be removed shall be entitled to notice of the meeting at which such removal is to be voted upon and shall be entitled to appear and be heard at such meeting Tebruary 26 1936

Section 12. <u>Compensation</u>. Members shall not receive any stated salary for their services as members. The Board of Directors shall have power, in its discretion, to contract for and pay to members rendering unusual or special services to the Corporation, special compensation appropriate to the value of such services.

ARTICLE III

Board of Directors

Section 1. <u>Election</u> The business and property of the Corporation shall be managed and controlled by the members to hold office until the next annual meeting of the members or until the election and qualification of their respective successors, except as herein otherwise provided for filling vacancies. Directors need not be members of the Corporation at the time of election but shall become members immediately upon election. For any director who is not a member of the Koch family, his term of office shall not be more than two '2' years and he shall not be elected to consecutive terms. February 26 1987

- Section 2. Number. The number of directors of the Corporation shall be twelve '12), but such number may be increased or decreased by amendment to these ByLaws, in the manner set forth in Article VIII hereof. When the number of directors is so decreased by amendment adopted by the Board of Directors, each director in office shall serve until his term expires or until his resignation or removal as herein provided. February 20 2010
 - Section 3. <u>Resignation</u>. Any director may resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the Board of Directors
 - Section 4. <u>Vacancies</u>. Any vacancy in the Board of Directors occurring during the year, including any vacancy created by an increase in the number of directors, may be filled for the unexpired portion of the term by the directors then serving, although less than a quorum, by affirmative vote of the majority thereof. Any director so elected by the Board of Directors shall hold office until the next succeeding annual meeting of the members of the Corporation or until the election and qualification of his successor
 - Section 5 Annual Meetings. Immediately after each annual election, the newly elected directors may meet forthwith at the principal office of the Corporation for the purpose of organization, the election of officers, and the transaction of other business, and, if a quorum of the directors be then present, no prior notice of such meeting shall be required to be given. The place and time of such first meeting may, however, be fixed by written consent of all the directors
 - Section 6. <u>Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the President or Vice President, and must be called by either of them on the written request of any two (2) directors.
 - Section 7. Notice of Meetings. Notice of all directors' meetings except as herein otherwise provided, shall be given by mailing the same at least three (3) days or by telegraphing the same at least one (1) day before the meeting to the usual business or residence address of each director, but such notice may be waived by any director. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors may be held without notice at such time and place as shall be determined by the Board. Any business may be transacted at any directors' meeting. At any meeting at which every director shall be present, even though without any notice or waiver thereof, any business may be transacted.

Section 8. Quorum. At all meetings of the Board of Directors, a majority of the directors shall be necessary and sufficient to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the act of a majority of the directors present at any meeting at which there is a quorum shall be the act of the Board of Directors, except as may be otherwise specifically provided by statute or by these ByLaws. If at any meeting there is less than a quorum present, a majority of those present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice to any absent director.

Section 9. <u>Waiver of Notice</u>. Whenever under the provisions of any law or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation or ByLaws of this Corporation, the Corporation or the Board of Directors or any committee thereof is authorized to take any action after notice to the Directors of the Corporation or after the lapse of a prescribed period of time, such action may be taken without notice and without the lapse of any period of time, if at any time before or after such action is completed, such requirements are waived in writing by the person or persons entitled to such notice or entitled to participate in the action to be taken or by his authorized attorney.

Section 10. <u>Compensation</u> Directors shall not receive any stated salary for their services as Directors but by resolution of the Board, a fixed reasonable sum or expenses of attendance, if any, or both, may be allowed for attendance at each regular or special meeting of the Board. The Board of Directors shall have power, in its discretion, to contract for and to pay to directors rendering unusual or exceptional services to the Corporation, special compensation appropriate to the value of such services.

Section 11. <u>Powers</u>. All the corporate powers, except such as are otherwise provided for in these ByLaws and by the laws of the State of Florida, shall be and are hereby vested in and shall be exercised by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may, by general resolution, delegate to committees of their own number, or to officers of the Corporation, such powers as they may see fit.

Section 12. Constructive Presence at a Meeting. Any director or member of a committee shall be deemed present at a meeting of the Board of Directors or a committee if a conference telephone or similar communication equipment is used, by means of which all persons participating in such meeting can hear each other.

Section 13. <u>Cormittees</u>. There shall be established an executive committee from among the members of the Board as selected by a majority vote of the Board. In addition, the Chairman of the Board may establish such standing committees and ad hoc committees as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes of the Corporation.

The Executive Committee shall have full authority to conduct the business of the Corporation in accordance with the policies prescribed by the Board of Directors between regular or special meetings of the Ecard. The Executive Committee shall meet as often as it shall be necessary to discharge its duties. The President, or in his absence, the next officer in rank, shall have the power to call meetings of the Elecutive Committee. Reasonable notice of such meeting shall be communicated to the last recorded address or telephone number of each member of the Committee. A majority of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum and shall be sufficient to discharge its duties. The Executive Committee shall record its deliberations and decisions in appropriate minutes which shall be submitted to, and maintained by, the Secretary of the Corporation. The Executive Committee shall report its activities to the Board of Directors at the next ensuing regular or special meeting of the Board.

Other committees shall be advisory to the board of Directors. They shall neet as often as necessary to discharge the functions delegated to them. Any reports or recommendations made to the Board shall be in writing and shall be delivered at the meeting of the committee where the recommendation was adopted or approved. Any written reports shall be submitted to the Secretary of the Corporation for inclusion with the Corporation's records. Septemper 24, 1396

ARTICLE IV

Officers

Section 1. <u>Number</u>. The officers of the Corporation shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers with such powers and duties not inconsistent with these ByLaws as may be appointed and determined by the Board of Directors. Any two officers, except those of President and Vice President, may be held by the same person.

Section 2. Election, Term of Office and Qualification. The President shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors from among their number and other officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors from among such persons as the Board of Directors may see fit at the first meeting of the Board of Directors after the annual meeting of the members of the Corporation.

Section 3. <u>Vacancies</u>. In case any office of the Corporation becomes vacant by death, resignation, retirement, disqualification, or any other cause, the majority of the directors then in office, although less than a quorum, may elect an officer to fill such vacancy, and the office so elected shall hold office and serve until the first meeting of the Board of Directors after the annual meeting of the members next succeeding and until the election and qualification of his successor

Section 4. <u>President</u>. The President shall preside at all meetings of members of the Board of Directors. He shall have and exercise general charge and supervision of the affairs of the Corporation and shall do and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Vice President. At the request of the President, or in the event of his absence or disability, the Vice President shall perform the duties and possess and exercise the powers of the President; and to the extent authorized by law, the Vice President shall have such other powers as the Board of Directors may determine and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Board of Directors.

Section 6. Secretary. The Secretary shall have charge of such books, documents and papers as the Board of Directors may determine and shall have the custody of the Corporate seal. He shall attend and keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors and members of the Corporation. He shall keep a record, containing the names, alphabetically arranged, of all persons who are members of the Corporation, showing their places of residence, and such book shall be open for inspection as prescribed by law. He may sign with the President or Vice President, in the name and on behalf of the Corporation, any contract or agreement authorized by the Board of Directors, and when so authorized or ordered by the Board of Directors, he may affix the seal of the Corporation. He shall in general perform all the duties incident to the office of Secretary, subject to the control of the Board of Directors, and shall do an perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the Board of Directors

Section 7. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall have the custody of all funds, property and securities of the Corporation, subject to such regulations as may be imposed by the Board of Directors. He may be required to give bond for the faithful performance of his duties, in such sum and with such sureties as the Board of Directors may require. When necessary or appropriate he may endorse on behalf of the Corporation for collection, checks, notes and other obligations, and shall deposit the same to the credit of the Corporation at such bank or banks or depository as the Board of Directors may designate. shall make such payments as may be necessary or proper to be made on behalf of the Corporation. He shall enter regularly on the books of the Corporation to be kept by him for that purpose, full and accurate account of all monies and obligations received and paid or incurred by him for or on account of the Corporation, and shall exhibit such books at all reasonable times to any director or member on application at the office of the Corporation He shall, in general, perform all duties incident to the office of Treasurer, subject to the control of the Board of Directors.

Section 8. <u>Salaries</u>. The salaries of all officers shall be fixed by the Board of Directors and shall be reasonable in amount. The fact that any officer is a member of the Corporation or a director shall not preclude his receiving a salary or voting on the resolution providing for the same.

Section 9. Removal. Any officer may be removed from office by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the directors in attendance at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors at which a quorum is present. Any action by the Board of Directors shall not affect the contractual or other rights that the officer may have as a result of his employment relationship with the Corporation. Feormary 26 1986

ARTICLE V

Investments

Section 1. <u>Investments</u>. The Corporation shall have the right to retain all or any part of any securities or property acquired by it in whatever manner, and to invest and reinvest any funds held by it, according to the judgment of the Board of Directors, without being restricted to the class of investment which a trustee is or may be permitted by law to make or by any similar restriction, provided, however, that no action shall be taken by or on behalf of the Corporation if such action is a prohibited transaction or would result in the denial of the tax exemption under Section 503 or Section 507 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended

Section 2. Voting Shares. Unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors, the President shall have full power and authority on behalf of the Corporation to vote either in person or by proxy at any meeting of the shareholders of any corporation in which the Corporation may hold shares, and at any such meeting may possess and exercise all of the rights and powers incident to the ownership of such shares which, as the owner thereof, this Corporation might have possesses and exercised if present. The Board of Directors may confer like powers upon any other person and may revoke any such powers as granted at its pleasure.

ARTICLE VI

Contracts, Loans, Checks and Deposits

Section 1. <u>Contracts</u>. The Board of Directors may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances

Section 2. <u>Loans</u>. No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Corporation and no evidence of indebtedness shall be issued in its name unless authorized by a resolution of the Board of Directors. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

Section 3. Checks, Drafts, Etc. All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agents or agents of the Corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 4. <u>Deposits</u>. All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select.

ARTICLE VII

Restrictions

Section 1. Prohibition Against Benefit. No member, director, officer or employee of, or member of a committee of, or person connected with the Corporation, or any other private individual shall receive at any time any of the net earnings or pecuniary profit from the operations of the Corporation, provided that this shall not prevent the payment to any such person of such reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the Corporation in effecting any of its purposes; and no such person or persons shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation. All members of the Corporation shall be deemed to have expressly consented and agreed that upon dissolution or winding up of the affairs of the Corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, the assets of the Corporation, after all debts have been satisfied, then remaining in the hands of the Board of Directors shall be distributed, transferred, conveyed, delivered, and paid over, in such amounts as the Board of Directors may determine or as may be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction upon application of the Board of Directors, exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational organizations which qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

Section 2. Exempt Activities. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the ByLaws, no member, director, officer, employee or representative of this Corporation shall take any action or carry on any activity by or on behalf of the Corporation not permitted to be taken or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendments

The Board of Directors shall have power to make, alter, amend and repeal the ByLaws of the Corporation by affirmative vote of a majority of the Board.
