SCHOLARSHIP STANDARDS

The Community Scholarship Committees and the Trustee shall apply the following guidelines in providing and granting scholarships to applicants:

- 1. Applicants must be graduating seniors or graduates of the Stanford Montana High School or the Denton Montana High School.
- 2. Applicants must have attended Stanford High School or Denton High School for the entire two academic years immediately preceding graduation from high school.
- 3. Graduates of the classes of 1989 and after from Stanford High School and Denton High School will be eligible for scholarships.
- 4. In order to be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must submit an initial application, on a form devised for that purpose by the Community Scholarship Committees, not later than two years after the date of the applicants graduation from high school, except if a scholarship applicant enters military service within two years after graduation from high school, the period of time for applying for a scholarship is extended by the time the applicant spends on active military duty
- 5. Applicants must submit applications to the superintendents of their high school no later than April 1st of the year in which they intend to use the scholarship funds.
- 6. The Community Scholarship Committees and Trustee shall meet each year in April to review applications for RUDY SUDEN SCHOLARSHIPS at the graduation Ceremonies of the Stanford High School and Denton High School.
- 7. The Community Scholarship Committees and the Trustee shall consider applications and grant scholarships using the criteria set forth in RUDOLPH "RUDY" SUDEN'S Will, those criteria being community involvement, academic qualifications, and need. The Community Scholarship Committees and the Trustee shall not use any other criteria for considering applications and granting scholarships.
- 8. The Community Scholarship Committees and Trustee may, at their discretion, renew scholarships on a yearly basis for up to four (4) years of higher education upon the application for such a scholarship and proof by the applicant that the applicant has maintained at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, on a scale of 4.0, for a C+ average, that the applicant completed forty-five (45) credits of higher education credit or the equivalent of a normal course load for each year in attendance at a school of higher education, and that the applicant has maintained satisfactory attendance in some course of undergraduate study leading to graduation.
- 9. Scholarship recipients must submit official transcripts, as soon as such transcripts are available, and must submit to the Trustee receipts showing payment of fees immediately upon payment of those fees for each grading period for which the recipient received scholarship funds from the RUDY SUDEN SCHOLARSHIP TRUST. The failure of a scholarship recipient to submit such official transcripts and receipts shall provide the Trustee with grounds for revoking or suspending a scholarship and seeking reimbursement of trust funds for any academic period for which such transcript or receipt is not submitted.

After consulting with the appropriate Community Scholarship Committee, the Trustee, in its discretion, may revoke or suspend a scholarship whenever a scholarship recipient's academic performance or conduct is such that the award of a scholarship would not be in keeping with the intent of RUDY SUDEN or the terms expressed in his Will.
