The Balance Sheet and Income Statement reports contain many errors. I have spoken to Mike MacKay on several occasions on this matter. He is reluctant to make all the changes required to correct these reports.

I believe all of these errors were caused by not having a working knowledge of double-entry bookkeeping and standard accounting practices. I can find no evidence of miss-appropriation of funds by Mike MacKay.

All of my data sheets and marked up copies of these reports highlighting the errors are attached to this letter.

At this time reconstruction of the data base is impossible. I am recommending the new officers of Post 2006 for the year 2013 ignore all of the financial data of the past year, using only end results as beginning entries and start over with data entry when we accept responsibility for the new year, and take a complete inventory of our assets.

The past Officers of the Post are held responsible for the financial state of the Post and are required to complete all official I.R.S. Forms and any other documents required Amvets By-laws.

A copy of this letter with attached documents and a copy of the accounting program shall be kept.
