Constitutionally Speaking – (Advancement of Justice Fund; Arthur & Esther Nighswander Justice Fund; The McLane Fund)

Support of the Constitutionally Speaking program which informs citizens about the NH and US Constitutions, aids them in understanding the American system of justice and how our courts work and teaches them about our government and what the role of the citizen is.

# Filmmakers Collaborative (Fiscal Agent/Telling My Story) - \$20,000

Telling My Story - (Charles W. Dean Trust Fund)

The grant is to be used for completing a 1-hour film about Ivy League students and women prisoners working together to write and perform an original play about women in prison. The film will provide a first-hand exploration of class differences, poverty and social abandonment, addiction and incarceration while modeling ways to combat these social ills. The completed documentary's intent, via public television, is to educate the public about the legal system and encourage viewers to become advocates for equal justice for all people.
