During the first three years of operation (FY2008 - Partial year; FY2009 and FY2010) we recieved a large grant from the Ford Foundation of \$250,000 paid over two years that fell over three Fiscal years (FY08=\$49,794; FY09=\$109,800 and FY10=\$90,406). This may be considered an unusual grant in some ways as it was our first grant from the Ford Foundation and larger than other grants we had recieved to date. However, it was a grant we applied for so was not unexpected. The grant was for a special project to develop the http://www.agentorange.com website, to provide accurate information the impact of Agent Orange/Dioxin on US veterans and Vietnamese, as well as to conduct education and advocacy on the Agent Orange. We received this early in our history so did not have other donors and foundation grants to offset the large grant. If the Ford grant was considered 'unusual' our Public support for the time period (FY09-13) would equal 32.8%. Just under 33.3%. In addition, in FY2010, WLP received a large grant from the Chino Cienega Foundation (CCF) of \$73,000 for a special project to help develop a Mine/UXO Awareness Museum in Quang Tri, Vietnam with our Vietnamese partners, Project Renew. The center is visited by hundreds of school children, tourist, local and foreign delegations who learn about the dangers of unexploded ordinance in Vietnam. We had received funding from CCF prior to this grant however our normal grant from CCF for our programs in Southeast Asia is usually \$50,000 or less. The grant for the Center was out of the ordinary, but perhaps not unusual in the IRS definition. But if it was excluded along with the Ford Grant our Public support for the FY2009-13 would be 37.27%. 2. Even if the Ford and CCF grants could not be excluded our public support is over 24%. Our donations from the general public has risen steadily since our full FY in 2009. FY09=\$7400; FY10=\$11,900; FY11=\$20,674; FY12=\$33,916 and for FY14 our public support was \$44,263, nearly fifty percent of the total income for FY2013. This is the result of greater focus on fundraising campaigns and diversifying out donors. 3. WLP is on track in FY2014 to meet the 33.3% public support test. This in part to the dropping off of the Ford Grant from our calculation but also due to diversified donors and more active fundraising campaigns. We have also applied for a USAID grant for a project in Vietnam. 4. WLP has an independent board of directors composed of individuals who have experience and expertise working in our program areas and geographical area in Vietnam and Laos. The board includes: Academics, Vietnamese- Americans, and Southeast Asian development experts. 5. WLP conducts public education programs across the United States at universities and community groups. It participates in conferences; writes articles; assists/advises journalists, the media, students, educators and film makers; as well as provides information about Agent Orange/Dioxin to US veterans and their families. WLP had over 9000 return visitors to our http://www.agentorangerecord.com website in FY2013 alone.
