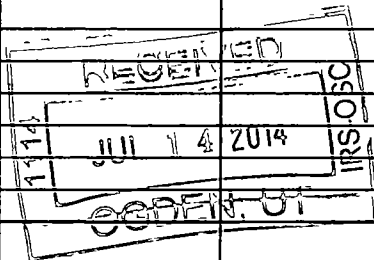

BLANCHE G. TERRY

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Blanche G. Terry Scholarship is to provide financial assistance for attendance at Texas post-secondary institutions to needy and deserving young men.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. High School graduate.
2. Not over the age of 21 at the time of initial application.
3. Not related to Blanche G. Terry.
4. Not related to member of Blanche G. Terry Scholarship Committee.
5. Must plan to be in full (minimum of 12 semester hours or equivalent) attendance at post-secondary institution in the State of Texas during the fall semester of the year in which the application is submitted.
6. Must pass at least 12 semester hours or equivalent with at least a 2.0 or "C" grade point average at the post-secondary institution attended to continue eligibility.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION:

The completed application along with supporting documentation shall be sent to Citizens National Bank Trust Department, 400 West Collin, Corsicana, Texas 75110 by April 17th of the year in which student hopes to receive the scholarship. The Committee will evaluate the applications and interview applicants by May 21st.

Selection will be based on financial need and academic promise as determined by the Committee, and will be made without regard to race, creed, color, or national origin. Preference will be given to residents of Navarro County because of the relatively small size of the Trust.

AMOUNT AND USE OF FUNDS:

1. Amount of the scholarship will be determined on an individual basis, but, generally will not exceed \$700.00 per semester or \$1,400.00 per nine month academic year.
2. Scholarship cannot continue for more than eight semesters or the equivalent without additional consideration by Committee.
3. Funds will be expended for direct educational expenses only, meaning tuition, mandatory fees, books, supplies, room and/or board (on campus).
4. Scholarships can be adjusted by the Committee on an annual basis on availability of funds.
5. Funds will be paid directly to the institution student plans to attend when possible. Otherwise, student will be required to present receipts clearly identifying expenditures for reimbursement from the Blanche G. Terry Scholarship Trust.

Any circumstances not provided for in these guidelines will be considered by the Committee and/or Trustee as they arise.
