Schedule L, Part IV - In the fiscal year ended 2013, the university solicited proposals for construction of a new residence hall. After careful review by senior management and the board, Northland Associates was selected as general contractor for the project. Trustee James Tyler is president and owner of Northland Associates and therefore was recused from the board's deliberations and decision to award the contract to Northland. This was a guaranteed maximum contract and the total estimated amount paid to Northland for the project, a new residence hall, was \$13,000,000. During construction, the university decided to renovate the quad which abuts the hall and awarded the contract to Northland as they were already onsite. Again, Mr. Tyler recused himself from the board's deliberations and decision. Total estimated costs for the quad renovation are \$1,200,000. Several years ago, the university investment committee committed \$5,000,000 to the private equity fund Diamond Castle, L.P. of which current trustee Michael Ranger, is a general partner. He was not a trustee when the university first invested with Diamond Castle. The value of the university's investment with Diamond Castle at 6/30/14 was \$2,230,326. This does not include distributions received over the years of investment.

Grandfield and Dodd employ brokerage services from the firm of MacAllaster Pitfield of which Trustee David MacAllaster is an owner.
