	students and faculty. This program service is carried out through the Foundation's sole member FMU Student Housing, LLC. All
	evenue generated by the LLC from housing services are managed and held by the Foundation. Housing Services are provided
	orimarily during the fall and spring semesters with minor revenues being received for summer semesters, fees and fines, and summer
	camp housing for FMU Summer Programs. Occupancy for fall 2013 was down from the prior year at 94.80% or 1,459 of the 1,539
	available beds. Spring 2014 was also down at an occupancy of 84.08% or 1,294 of the 1,539 available beds. Expenses were directly
	elated to operations of Housing Services. Property management is contracted out to the University which is paid \$135,000 for this
	service and reimbursed for all expenses related to this service of \$2,462,671. \$1,057,131 is attributable to interest on bonds issued in
	2004 and 2006 for our Forest Villa Apartments. \$377,215 was rent paid to the University as part of the lease agreement between the
	LC and the University to lease University owned housing. Lastly, \$551,865 was depreciation and amortization expenses of assets,
	ound costs, and leasehold costs of the LLC for its housing services. Remaining expenses were insurance and other miscellaneous
	costs.
