Club for Growth is a nationwide nonprofit membership organization dedicated to promoting public policies that promote economic growth primarily through legislative involvement, issue advocacy, research, and training and educational activity and may engage in any other lawful purpose.

Statement of Program Service Accomplishments, Line 4

a. Public education and research \$406,845

The organization conducts a program of public education through speeches, articles and TV and radio news interviews to educate citizens on the benefits of pro-growth policies and the work of the organization. Staff members wrote articles on topics including economic policy, tax policy and excessive spending that appeared in leading newspapers and news outlets, including *The Wall Street Journal* and *USA Today*, two of America's most influential publications covering public policy. Staff members appeared on many nationally distributed TV and radio news programs and dozens of local radio programs and were quoted in numerous newspapers and online news sites.

b. Publications \$345,819

The organization publishes information in print, on the Internet and through DVD's to educate on economic issues and to motivate people to act in support of pro-economic growth policies. Its blog published 97 entries and was visited by over 106,000 unique visitors during the fiscal year. It publishes a membership newsletter that has a printed circulation of over 36,000 copies. The organization also publishes information on Facebook and Twitter and posted hundreds of times using the mediums. We also maintain a listsery on free trade issues whose subscribers are primarily well known public policy advocates. Further, we publish an annual Congressional Scorecard on pro-growth economic policy issues.

c. Legislative Involvement and Policy Advocacy \$671,295

The organization monitors legislation that can help or harm economic growth, and urges its adoption or rejection by the U.S. Congress and the President. In addition to its public education efforts, such actions for legislative involvement and policy advocacy included 33 Key Vote Alerts, 12 coalition letters, and 29 press releases. To further its efforts to enact pro-economic growth legislation, the organization also periodically publishes reports on congressional roll call votes on legislation that would impact economic growth for distribution to the media, its members and the public.

d. Lectures and Conferences \$519,002

The organization conducted one conference during the fiscal year on economic policies that can increase economic growth. Conference presentations were made by ten members of Congress, four current Governors, and ten economists, journalists and media personalities

e. Other \$91,265

In order to further its goal to foster economic growth, the organization operated other programs not mentioned above. The programs related to economic growth, such as fiscal responsibility, tax policies and legal reform.
