An independent appraisal of the 3,000,000 shares donated to the Foundation in 2011 was performed as of June 22, 2011 and the appraiser opined that the adjustment applicable to the 3,000,000 shares of CHH was 7.5%. An updated independent appraisal was performed as of June 30, 2013 in which the appraiser opined that the appropriate adjustment applicable to the remaining 2,441,000 shares of CHH owned as of that date was 9.7%. As of June 30, 2014 the Foundation owned a total of 633,237 shares of CHH stock. Considering the significant reduction in and remaining number of shares, a discount of 9% was used for the purpose of calculating the average monthly fair market value of CHH stock included in line 1a of Part X.
