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

# Rental Assistance

TURN has a variety of rental subsidy programs. TURN's grant programs assist low-income Philadelphia residents facing homelessness with back rent, security deposits for a new residence, or cash assistance for the highest utility bill in any month. New funding is not always available so please call first at 215-940-3900.

# Housing Disamination

TURN assists tenants with filing housing discrimination claims based on race, sexual harassment, children, sexual orientation, or other illegal categories or when a landlord fails to accommodate a tenant's disability (including HIV/AIDS). TURN's trained counselors can help arrange testing and help find legal representation where appropriate.
