The Board of Regents Executive Committee shall take action on any presumed or potential violation of this policy by a member of leadership to ensure that a conflict of interest does not arise or does not continue. In addition to any legal penalties, such action may include, but shall not be limited to, oral admonishment, written reprimand, resignation, and restitution. A member of leadership who disagrees with the findings or recommendations of the Finance Committee or the action of the Board of Regents Executive Committee may appeal the decision to 990, Part VI, Line 15 - The College has policies and procedures concerning compensation increases, performance evaluations, and Job evaluations In addition, merit increases are included as a budget parameter for review by the ACS Finance Committee as is the addition of any new employee or human resource benefit proposal.
