Form 990, Part VI, Section A, Line 7b - The Emergency Manager of Detroit Public Schools (DPS) must approve the organization's acceptance of the following donor restricted contributions:contributions for new programs or for capital asset acquisition requiring expenditures by DPS that are not fully funded by the contribution or other reasonably anticipated contributions; contribution for purposes or programs not consistent with then current DPS policies; contribution for purpose of funding scholarships for DPS students or others; donation of real estate or tangible personal property intended for use directly by DPS; contribution requiring that the organization or DPS act as a trustee or fiduciary for the donor, any other individual, or an organization not controlled by the organization or DPS; contribution requiring the organization or DPS to furnish goods, services, or other consideration to the donor or to another private entity in exchange for the contribution (other than a contribution made in connection with a dinner, outing, or other bona fide fundraising event sponsored by the organization, or a token of appreciation less than \$100 in value); contribution that requires DPS to name a facility or program for the donor or any other person or provide other unusual forms of donor recognition; contribution to be held by the organization or Detroit Public Schools as donor advised funds

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 11b - The organization's CEO and COO review the proposed Form 990 with the Chair of the Board of Directors. It is then circulated to all board members for review and comments. Once the 990 is finalized, it is presented to the board for official approval.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c - Directors are required to disclose any conflicts of interest or potential conflicts of interest with respect to grants, contracts, and transactions submitted to the board for approval. A director who has a conflict of interest or potential conflict of interest is prohibited from voting on grant, contract or transaction.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - An independent consultant was engaged to collect and analyze comparability data to review the reasonableness of compensation when the first President and CEO was originally hired. The data was reviewed by the Board Chair, who determined that the compensation was reasonable based on the data compiled. The data was reviewed by the board of directors, who approved the compensation. The compensation of the organization's current President, who succeeded the first President and CEO on October 31, 2012 is considerably lower than that paid to the first President and CEO. To determine the reasonableness of the compensation for the General Counsel and COO, the President and CEO consulted the most recent compensation survey published by the Michigan Nonprofit Association. She then presented the finding and compensation recommendations to the organization's Compensation Committee which approved the recommended compensation. The compensation of the General Counsel and COO has not increased since it was initially approved by the Compensation Committee.

Form 990, Part VI, Section C, Line 19 - The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, State of Michigan, posts the organization's Articles of Incorporation on its website which can be viewed by the public. The Michigan Attorney General's Office, Charitable Trust Division, posts financial information regarding the organization on its website, which can also be viewed by the public. The Guidestar website posts the organization's Form 990, which can be viewed by the public. Other governing documents and financial statements are not generally available to the public, however, if a donor, potential donor, or member of the general public requests a copy of these documents, the organization may provide them, depending on the circumstances.
