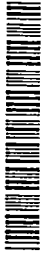

- (c) Any special time constraints on the receipt of the contribution; i.e., fiscal year end, capital or operating support campaign ending on a specific date, etc.

Page 2: Evidence from the IRS of your current 501 (c) (3) status.

Page 3-5: Any supporting documentation you wish to include.

Proposals may be submitted at any time, however, the Board of Directors customarily meets in June of each year to decide on distributions for the year.
