The University believes that it has appropriate support for any tax positions taken affecting its annual filing requirements, and as such, does not have any uncertain tax positions that are material to the financial statements. The entities would recognize future accrued interest and penalties related to unrecognized tax benefits and liabilities in income tax expense if such interest and penalties are incurred. The University is a nonprofit organization that is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). While preparing the Form 990, it was discovered the University would have a Form 990-T filing requirement and as a result is filing a 990-T for the year ending June 30, 2014.
