In 2013, these chapters met 348 requests for goods or services from 291 families, 62% of whom were completely new to First In Families.

Aging Grant: In Year Two of this project, FIFNC grew upon the previous year's cross-training activities and played an integral role in the creation of a Durham County Community Resource Connections organization to support the needs of individuals who are aging adults with disabilities. Formal and informal supports, including access to and information about future planning, were provided in three different locations in North Carolina; 71% of all adults with intellectual disability in NC live with their families. In addition this grant provided wills and estates planning workshops and future planning information through two workshops (in Winston-Salem and Shelby) and one on one conversations with caregivers.
