After reviewing comparable compensation data and providing 360 degree performance feedback, the Board and its committees recommended and approved the annual CEO compensation. This formal compensation program includes job descriptions, annual evaluations, comparable market based salary data and compensation philosphy that supports the mission, goals and objectives of the organization.
