Via Christi Health, Inc., as a Catholic Health Care System, has its origins in faith-based responses to health needs of our communities, with a particular concern for those living in poverty and who are vulnerable. In addition to typical inpatient and outpatient services, Via Christi Health, Inc. operates primary care clinics, a low income neighborhood outreach clinic, specialty hospitals and centers, home medical services, therapy centers, and long-term care villages. Specific exempt purpose achievements include - Management of acute care facilities throughout Kansas that include hospital facilities housing over 1,300 beds, a rehabilitation center that is the hub for 12 outpatient rehabilitation clinics, an occupational and environmental medicine program and a sports medicine program, a research program, a home health program, and 17 family medicine clinics - Management of senior care facilities that serve more than 1,300 residents in its 12 senior communities and programs in Kansas and Oklahoma - Management of an outpatient and retail division that includes a portfolio of companies providing ambulatory surgery, diagnostic imaging, durable medical equipment, and real estate holdings. This division also includes outpatient care services that are delivered through joint ventures with local physicians. 
