The Baltimore Fund LLC:

The Baltimore Fund LLC (the “Fund”) is a partnership organized in Maryland on June 26, 2002 to raise \$15 million in contributions, primarily from charitable organizations. According to the partnership documents, the Fund will invest substantially all of its funds in TRF Urban Growth Partners, L.P. (“UGP”), a 16-year-old community development fund. The purpose of UGP is to invest in urban-based growth companies to produce economic development benefits including increasing the supply and quality of employment, the formation rate of urban businesses, affordable housing, technical and capital assistance, and the availability of commercial properties. UGP invests only in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and the Baltimore/Washington areas.

The purposes of the Fund are to direct investment dollars into businesses in Baltimore, Maryland and the five surrounding counties forming the Baltimore metropolitan area to enable these businesses to provide high-quality job opportunities and employment training to low and moderate income residents of Baltimore. The Operating Agreement further states that the purposes of the Fund shall be (i) to purchase, hold and exercise the rights of ownership with respect to an investment in the UGP Fund, in whole or in part as a PRI [Program Related Investment] within the meaning of Code Section 4944(c) ... (ii) to conduct any business that may be lawfully conducted by a limited liability company ... and (iii) to do anything necessary or incidental to the foregoing. UGP has agreed to make investments in companies located in the Baltimore area equal to the Fund’s investment in UGP.
