Leagues conducted grassroots voter registration campaigns across the country, focusing primarily on the hardest-to-reach new voters, including young people, racial minorities and new citizens, who are underserved by traditional registration efforts and consequently left on the sidelines of the election process. Increased voter registration and perticipation in these communities is essential to building an electorate that more fully represents the diversity of our nation and a government more responsive to all its people. Youth voter registration was a focal point of the League's efforts. Young people now make up a major subset of the American demographic and have the potential to affect the outcome of every election. However, they remain significantly underrepresented within the electorate, with lack of registration being a primary barrier to their participation. To fill the gaps in youth voter registration, local Leagues across the country have especially helped high school and community college students register to vote. In 2013, the LWVEF released an update of our popular training manual for high school voter registration drives, Empowering the Voters of Tomorrow: Developing Winning High School Voter Registration Programs. The new and Improved manual features a step-bystep guide for conducting effective high school voter registration drives for organizations, educators and students interested in Inspiring and empowering young Americans to register and vote. To reach additional underrepresented voters, LWVEF staff provided ongoing guidance to Leagues conducting naturalization ceremony work in key states and was once again the leading on-the- ground participant in National Voter Registration Day. On September 24 alone, thousands of volunteers from nearly 300 Leagues in more than 45 states registered an incredible more than 10,000 voters. The League was also the central planner of a marquee event at Bryant Park in New York City. Featured speakers included LWVEF Chair Elisabeth MacNamara actress America Ferrera, and Mike Ryan, Executive Director of the NYC Board of Elections. A lack of information on the candidates, issues and election processes is a key obstacle keeping many underrepresented groups of voters from the polls. Fortunately, there is no better national source of election-related information than the League's VOTE411.org website. An indispensable resource for voters, VOTE411 is used by the media, thousands of League partner organizations and hundreds of League volunteer teams to provide voters with all the information they need to successfully cast a ballot and have it counted. In 2013, the League used VOTE411 to provide an unprecedented breadth of localized, nonpartisan information about the candidates and ballot issues, polling place hours and locations, early or absentee voting rules, local and state voting requirements and regulations, and an
