INDIAN RECRUITMENT PROGRAM AND BILLY MILLS SPEAKERS IN CALIFORNIA, THE
BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF THE NORTHERN CHEYENNE NATION IN MONTANA, THE
DENVER INDIAN CENTER AND THE DENVER INDIAN FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER IN
COLORADO, THE DEPARTMENT OF INDIAN WORK IN MINNESOTA, THE EUCHEE
LANGUAGE PROJECT AND THE FELLOWSHIP OF AMERICAN INDIANS IN OKLAHOMA,
GLOBAL RUNNING CULTURE IN NEW MEXICO, HAYWARD COMMUNITY SCHOOLS IN
WISCONSIN, IHANKTOWAN YOUTH IN SOUTH DAKOTA, INDIAN YOUTH OF AMERICA IN
IOWA, NEZ PERCE TRIBE SOCIAL SERVICES IN IDAHO, THE NORTH AMERICAN
INDIAN CENTER OF BOSTON IN MASSACHUSETTS, NESPELEM CREEK KIDS 4-H CLUB

LEAD IN ARIZONA. BETWEEN THESE 17 GROUPS AND THE OTHERS MENTIONED
ABOVE, RUNNING STRONG PROVIDED 4,743 NEW WINTER COATS WITH HOODS, 2,616
NEW WARM WINTER HATS, 2,475 SCARVES, AND 2,475 PAIRS OF GLOVES TO

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CHILDREN AND FAMILIES TO HELP WITH COLD WINTER WEATHER. RUNNING STRONG ALSO PROVIDED 3,955 BACKPACKS FILLED WITH SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS AND 2,745 BACKPACKS FILLED WITH SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR JR. HIGH/HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

WE ALSO SERVED A HEALTHY SACK LUNCH TO CHEYENNE RIVER KIDS IN FOUR COMMUNITIES SO THAT THESE KIDS HAVE SOMETHING TO EAT DURING THEIR SUMMER VACATION (WE SERVED 5,047 MEALS AT 4 SITES OVER 12 WEEKS, AVERAGING 87 KIDS SERVED PER DAY). TO STRETCH DOLLARS DURING THE NORTHERN PLAINS WINTER, OUR EMERGENCY HEAT MATCHES PROVIDED HEATING ASSISTANCE TO 1,128 PINE RIDGE FAMILIES (\$100 MATCH PER FAMILY) AND TO 216 CHEYENNE RIVER YOUTH PROJECT MEMBER FAMILIES AND HELPED KEEP TWO YOUTH CENTERS DOORS OPEN (216 FAMILIES, 1,318 INDIVIDUALS SERVED, 795 OF WHOM ARE CHILDREN). ON CHEYENNE RIVER, RUNNING STRONG PROVIDED FUNDS TO PURCHASE MEAT AND FRUIT AND VEGETABLES FOR KIDS WHO CAME TO THE CHEYENNE RIVER YOUTH PROJECT.

WE ALSO WORKED WITH CHEYENNE RIVER'S TAKINI SCHOOL TO GIVE KIDS A BACKPACK FULL OF FOOD ON WEEKENDS AND SCHOOL BREAKS SO THAT THEY DIDN'T GO HUNGRY (120 KIDS PER WEEK FOR 36 WEEKS = 4,320 SACKS OF FOOD) AND BOUGHT NEW TEXT BOOKS FOR A 6TH GRADE CLASS WHERE STUDENTS WERE SHARING BOOKS. WE REPLICATED OUR BACKPACK FOOD PROGRAM ON THE MENOMINEE INDIAN RESERVATION IN WISCONSIN, SERVING HEALTHY "SMART SACKS" FOR 4 YEAR OLD PRE-K - 3RD GRADE STUDENTS (450 KIDS FOR 30 WEEKS = 13,500 SACKS OF FOOD). KIDS WERE NOT ONLY KEPT FROM BEING HUNGRY, THEY LEARNED ABOUT NUTRITION AND EXERCISE AS PART OF A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE HEALTHY LIFE CHOICES.

WE SUPPORTED LAKOTA CHILDREN'S ENRICHMENT'S YOUTH SUMMITS ON PINE RIDGE, WISDOM OF THE ELDER'S YOUTH LEADERSHIP WORK IN OREGON AND TODAY WE FOLLOW, TOMORROW WE LEAD'S YOUTH CAMPS ON THE NAVAJO INDIAN RESERVATION (500 SERVED). WE SUPPORTED NEW MEXICO-BASED WINGS OF AMERICA'S YOUTH RUNNING OUTREACH (92 SERVED) AND CALIFORNIA'S NATIVE DAD'S NETWORK. WE SUPPORTED CHRISTMAS PARTIES WITH THE TETON COALITION IN RAPID CITY, SD (500 SERVED), BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF THE NORTHERN CHEYENNE NATION (ESTIMATED 120 SERVED), AND THE CHEYENNE RIVER YOUTH PROJECT'S ANNUAL TOY DRIVE TO ANSWER THE WISHES OF 1,200 CHILDREN'S LETTERS TO SANTA. WE SUPPORTED THE BRAVE HEART SOCIETY'S EFFORTS TO RECONNECT YANKTON WOMEN AND GIRLS TO THEIR CULTURAL STRENGTH THROUGH RITES OF PASSAGE, STORYTELLING GATHERINGS, LANGUAGE NESTS AND HEALING RETREATS (500 SERVED), THE AMERICAN HORSE AFRAID OF BEAR SUNDANCE IN THE BLACK HILLS (73 DANCERS PLUS SUPPORTERS SERVED), AND THE FT. WE SUPPORTED THE SEVEN DANCER'S COALITION'S IONWARIWAKAION YOUTH CULTURE CLUB IN MOHAWK TERRITORY AT AKWESASNE, NY (50 SERVED), THE YUCHI LANGUAGE PROJECT'S EFFORTS TO SAVE THE EUCHEE LANGUAGE AND TRADITIONAL FOODS GARDEN IN OKLAHOMA (130 SERVED) AND KAH-BAY-KAH-NONG'S OJIBWE CULTURAL TEACHINGS AND YOUTH HOCKEY IN WISCONSIN (200 SERVED). AND, OUR NATIONAL SPOKESPERSON, OLYMPIC CHAMPION BILLY MILLS, TRAVELS THE COUNTRY, SPEAKING TO AMERICAN INDIAN YOUTH WITH HIS MESSAGE OF LIVING LIFE WITH DIGNITY, CHARACTER AND PRIDE IN WHO THEY ARE AS NATIVE PEOPLE.

IN AN EFFORT TO COMBAT THE SHORT NORTHERN PLAINS GROWING SEASON, WE HELPED CAN WIGMUNKE'S (THE RAINBOW TREE) EFFORTS TO INCREASE GREEN SPACES, GARDENS AND GOOD NUTRITION ON PINE RIDGE AND INVESTED IN REPAIRING AND MOVING THEIR GREENHOUSE.

ACTIVITIES INCLUDED CREATING SMALLER GROUPS TO PLANT GARDENS AND TREES, WORK WITH SCHOOLS AND HEAD STARTS, AS WELL AS EXPAND ITS FARMERS AND GATHERERS MARKETS TO AID THE RESERVATION ECONOMY (1,502 SERVED, 634 OF WHOM ARE YOUTH). WE DONATED TWO NEW GREENHOUSES, A 30' X 70' HOOP HOUSE FOR THE CHEYENNE RIVER YOUTH PROJECT'S CHILDREN'S GARDEN AND A 26' X 48' HIGH TUNNEL GREEN HOUSE FOR THE SLIM BUTTES AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ("SBAG") ON PINE RIDGE. SBAG TILLED 412 GARDENS AND DISTRIBUTED 16,000 SEEDLINGS GROWN IN BIODYNAMIC POTTING SOIL IN THE PROGRAM'S NEW 26' X 48' HOOP HOUSE (DONATED BY RUNNING STRONG IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR), AND INVOLVING 2,600 INDIVIDUALS ACROSS MOST OF PINE RIDGE - THE MAJORITY CHILDREN. MORE THAN JUST A GARDENING PROGRAM, SBAG

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PROVIDES ASSISTANCE ALL YEAR LONG FROM SUPPORTING CULTURAL AND YOUTH ACTIVITIES, TO USING TRACTORS TO PLOW OUT SNOWBOUND HOUSES TO DELIVERING FIREWOOD (1,800 SERVED). WE ALSO SUPPORTED THE EUCHEE (YUCHI) LANGUAGE PROJECT'S TRADITIONAL GARDEN IN SAPULPA, OK AND THE BRAVE HEART SOCIETY'S TRADITIONAL GARDENING EFFORTS. OTHER SUPPORT INCLUDED GRANTS TO HELP LONEMAN SCHOOL ON THE PINE RIDGE INDIAN RESERVATION, MAKE THEIR FIRST SCHOOL GARDEN.

HOUSING IS A CRITICAL NEED, WITH TOO MANY FAMILIES STILL LIVING IN SUBSTANDARD, UNSAFE OR OVERCROWDED HOUSING. RUNNING STRONG SUPPORTS SMALL-SCALE HOME REPAIRS WHICH HAVE THE CAPACITY TO MAKE A CRITICAL DIFFERENCE IN A FAMILY'S LIVING SITUATION. WE PARTNER WITH THE CHEYENNE RIVER YOUTH PROJECT TO MAKE HOME REPAIRS FOR 14 FAMILIES. REPAIRS RANGED FROM NEW WINDOWS AND DOORS TO KEEP OUT THE NORTHERN PLAINS COLD TO REPLACING FLOORING WITH HOLES IN IT. WE ALSO PARTNERED WITH THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE'S PARTNERSHIP FOR HOUSING TO MAKE HOME REPAIRS FOR 22 FAMILIES (119 SERVED, 69 OF WHOM WERE CHILDREN) ON PINE RIDGE. RUNNING STRONG FUNDS PAID FOR MATERIALS WITH ALL LABOR DONE BY VOLUNTEERS TO STRETCH OUR FUNDS. REPAIRS INCLUDED PLUMBING AND NEW WATER HEATERS, REPAIRING ROOFS AND ROTTEN FLOORS. AND FINALLY, RUNNING STRONG WAS ABLE TO FUND THE START-UP OF A HOME HEALTH AIDE PROGRAM ON PINE RIDGE, A COMMUNITY WHICH CURRENTLY DID NOT HAVE ANY HOME HEALTH AIDE SERVICES. OUR GRANT GOT THE PROGRAM UP AND RUNNING FOR 3 MONTHS UNTIL REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES COULD BEGIN.

THE DATA INCLUDED IN THE COMPARABILITY SURVEYS COMES FROM NUMEROUS SOURCES, SUCH AS ASSOCIATION SURVEYS AND CONSULTANT RESEARCH STUDIES.
