Storm closes schools, courts across West Virginia

CHARLESTON, W.Va. (AP) — Public school students across West Virginia are getting a day off because of a winter storm.

The state Department of Education's website shows schools in all 55 counties are closed Tuesday.

The West Virginia Supreme Court says courts in more than a dozen counties are closed because of the weather.

Marshall University also has canceled classes. The National Weather Service says Huntington received more than 10 inches of snow on Monday.

Charleston and Beckley each received about 7 inches of snow.

Appalachian Power reported about 1,400 outages Tuesday morning.

Most people stayed off the dangerous, snow-covered roads on Monday, after several inches of snow fell in Kanawha County and the surrounding region.


"The snow's coming down pretty good, but thank God, everyone has heeded the warnings and they're staying in," a Logan County dispatcher said around 2:30 p.m.

The National Weather Service issued a winter storm advisory for Kanawha, Putnam and surrounding counties until 5 a.m. Tuesday, and said to expect 8 to 10 inches of snow, with the most accumulation coming Monday afternoon and early evening. As of about 4 p.m., about 4 to 7 inches had fallen in most of Kanawha and surrounding counties, with about 9 inches in parts of Lincoln County, according to Jonathan Wolfe, meteorologist with the National Weather Service. Wolfe said the temperature hovered around 10 degrees most of the day, and was expected to remain around 10 degrees overnight.

"Tomorrow we warm up a bit to 24 degrees, then we have a cold snap after that," he said. "By Friday morning, we'll be at five below, and we might get another little bit of snow on Thursday morning."

He doesn't expect more than an inch or two of snow on Thursday.

Schools were closed Monday in at least 51 of 55 counties, according to the state

Department of Education's website. College classes and most of the flights at Yeager Airport were also canceled.

As of 7:30 p.m. Monday, schools in 42 counties, including Kanawha and Putnam, had closed for Tuesday.

Kanawha County Metro 911 dispatchers said the snow began falling in Kanawha County around 7:30 a.m., and roads were quickly covered because the ground was so cold. As of noon, about a dozen accidents had been reported in Kanawha County. By 2 p.m., about 30 accidents had been reported. Dispatchers said only a few minor accidents happened before 8:30 a.m.

Tractor-trailers were having trouble making it up a slick hill around the 50 mile marker, near the Institute exit, all day, backing up traffic, according to a Kanawha County Metro 911 dispatcher. She said at about 3:30 pm that within the last hour, the Division of Highways had begun diverting traffic off of the Institute exit to W.Va. 25 to allow salt trucks to get to the hill.

State Division of Highways spokeswoman Carrie Bly said snow plows were having trouble keeping up with the snow Monday morning. Snow removal was hampered by cold temperatures that make road salt less effective.

Bly said highway crews were concentrating on the state interstate system and hightraffic areas, and warned people who live on secondary routes that they may not see a snow plow until Tuesday.

She urged state residents to stay off the roads unless absolutely necessary. She also stressed that drivers should slow down on icy roads. "Definitely, 60 or 70 mph is not the speed you want to be driving if you have to go out," she said.

All Kanawha County offices were closed Monday because of the Presidents Day holiday, but Deputy Emergency Services Director C.W. Sigman said he and other emergency officials remained on alert. He said there were few weather-related problems Monday morning.

The Kanawha County Courthouse and Judicial Annex are also closed Tuesday, according to a release from the county. Courthouse and Annex employees are not required to work. The Kanawha County Ambulance Service and Sheriff's Department will remain open.

The city of Charleston canceled trash pickup for Tuesday. Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday's routes will each be delayed a day.

A Boone County emergency dispatcher said the snow started there around 5 a.m., and there were already a couple of inches on the ground by 7:30 a.m. By about 2:30 pm, about 6 inches were on the ground, a dispatcher said.

No major accidents had been reported, he said, even though the roads were slick.

"They are, but people have actually been smart about it for some reason," he said.

Officials for the West Virginia Tumpike said a few people slid off of the road Monday morning, probably from driving too fast for the road conditions. Throughout the day, most of the problems consisted of vehicles getting stuck in the snow.

A Mercer County dispatcher said a few weather-related accidents, but no injuries, had occurred as of about 3 p.m. He said dispatchers were listening to a traffic scanner, that indicated the worst problems were on Interstate 77.

"Most of the problems on your turnpike start in Princeton and end in Charleston," he said.

A Putnam County dispatcher said only one accident had been reported as of 2:30 p.m.

"Cars are just getting stuck on the roads," he said. "Wreckers are having to come pull them out. Other than that, there are no

major wrecks or anything like that."

In Logan County, the roads were covered with about 3 inches of snow around 7:45 a.m. By 2:30 p.m., about 6 and 1/2 inches of snow had fallen, according to an emergency dispatcher. But no weather-related accidents had been reported.

"I think it was well publicized and hopefully, everyone already got their bread and milk and will just stay home," a dispatcher said Monday morning. A dispatcher confirmed Monday afternoon that had been the case.

No weather-related accidents were reported in Mingo County as of about 3 p.m., according to a dispatcher. Dispatchers in Raleigh County also did not report any major accidents.

Kanawha County school officials closed schools at 7:15 a.m. Monday, and told any employees who had already reported to go home. Most other counties in the area closed schools on Sunday night.

All branches of the Kanawha County Public Library were also closed.

Marshall University closed at 10 a.m. and was shutting down all offices at

11 a.m., according to the school's website. West Virginia State University in Institute also canceled classes, as well as the annual WVSU Day at the state Legislature. Many government offices were already closed Monday because of the Presidents Day holiday.

The University of Charleston scheduled morning classes as usual at its main campus, but canceled afternoon and evening classes. Classes at UC's Beckley campus were canceled all day.

Nitro city officials decided to close City Hall on Tuesday, and said a Nitro City Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday night had been postponed.

Owners of the Charleston Town Center mall decided to close at 4 p.m., according to mall manager Lisa McCracken. She said Macy's decided to close at 2 p.m., and JCPenney never opened because of a lack of staff.

Yeager Airport Director Rick Atkinson said about 80 percent of the 28 flights scheduled for the airport were canceled. He said a few flights took off and departed in the morning, but by afternoon, all flights had been canceled except for a couple incoming flights late Monday night.

He said that passengers who had canceled flights should call or visit the website for the airlines to arrange new flights.

"All change fees have been waived by the airlines because of the winter storm, and they'll work with them on new flights," he said. A 3 p.m. charter for a performance of "Disney on Ice" scheduled for the Charleston Civic Center this coming weekend did make it into the airport Monday afternoon, Yeager said.

Some Kanawha County bus routes were altered because of the snow. For Tuesday, the Cabin Creek bus will not be going to Hernshaw Mountain or East Bank, and the Nitro bus will not be going behind Walmart or down Roxalana Road. The Woodward Drive bus will be turning around at Grandview Elementary, and the Tyler Mountain/Cross Lanes bus will be going out to McKowns Meat and turning back into town until the Interstate re-opens. Elkview, Campbell's Creek, Mont./Eskdale, Oakridge/Wertz, Garrison/Hillsdale, Beech Avenue, South Hills and Hillcrest/North Gate routes will be closed. The Sissonville bus will be turning around at Potalico Park-n-Ride. The Fort Hill/Montrose bus will take the Kanawha Turnpike to Riverwalk Plaza only. All runs to South Charleston Technology Park are canceled. The Southridge bus will not be going to Oakwood/Oakhurst, Davis Creek, Alum Creek or the access road to Home Depot. The Montgomery bus will not be going across the bridge to Witcher Creek and will be using Orchard Road.

KRT officials said they would update bus routes throughout the day on their Facebook page.
