SECU PROVIDES SERVICES TO OUR MEMBERS THROUGH 255 BRANCH OFFICES, OVER 1,100 ATMS, 24/7 CONTACT CENTERS AND A WEBSITE - WWW.NCSECU.ORG. AS A CREDIT UNION, MEMBERS DEPOSIT FUNDS INTO SHARE ACCOUNTS, WHICH ARE THEN LOANED TO OTHER MEMBERS. THE CREDIT UNION OFFERS SHARE ACCOUNTS OF VARIOUS TYPES: MEMBERSHIP SHARES, SHARE DRAFTS, MONEY MARKET SHARES, IRA SHARES, AND SHARE TERM CERTIFICATES. LOANS TO MEMBERS CONSIST OF MORTGAGE, HOME EQUITY, AUTO AND OTHER CONSUMER LOANS. AT JUNE 30, 2014, THERE WERE 628,000 PERSONAL LOANS AND 142,000 FIRST AND SECOND MORTGAGE LOANS OUTSTANDING. THE CREDIT UNION RECEIVED \$917,772,609 IN REVENUES FROM INTEREST ON LOANS, INTEREST ON INVESTMENTS, AND OTHER NON-INTEREST SOURCES DURING THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2014.
