FIRST AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF UNC ESHELMAN SCHOOL OF PHARMACY FOUNDATION

- 1. The name of the corporation is UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy Foundation (the "Foundation").
- 2. The Foundation shall be a charitable corporation within the meaning of Section 55A-1-40(4) of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
- 3. The Foundation is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any corresponding United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code"), including, without limitation, fostering and promoting the profession of pharmacy and pharmaceutical education and research exclusively at the UNC Eshelman School of Pharmacy.
 - (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of these First Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, the Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (ii) by a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.
 - (b) No part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its tax-exempt purposes.
 - (c) No substantial part of the activities of this Foundation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Foundation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- 4. The Foundation shall not have members. The method of election of the directors shall be set forth in the bylaws of the Foundation.
 - 5. The period of existence of the Foundation is unlimited.
- 6. The address of the registered office of the Foundation in the State of North Carolina is 194 Finley Golf Course Road, Suite 106, Chapel Hill, North Carolina 27517, which principal office is located in Orange County; and the name of its registered agent at such address is Alan Knight.
- 7. The mailing address and the street address of the principal office of the Foundation is 194 Finley Golf Course Road, Suite 106, Chapel Hill, North Carolina 27517, which principal office is located in Orange County.
- 8. To the fullest extent permitted by the North Carolina Nonprofit Corporation Act as it exists or may hereafter be amended, no person who is serving or who has served as a director

of the Foundation shall be personally liable for monetary damages for breach of any duty as a director. No amendment or repeal of this article, nor the adoption of any other amendment to these First Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this article, shall eliminate or reduce the protection granted herein with respect to any matter that occurred prior to such amendment, repeal, or adoption.

- In the event of the termination, dissolution or winding up of the affairs of the Foundation in any manner or for any reason whatsoever, the directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all liabilities of the Foundation, distribute all of the remaining assets and property of the Foundation to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (the "University") or a University-approved associated entity, unless otherwise designated by the donor of the assets, provided that the University, the University-approved associated entity and/or the designee of the donor of an asset qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. In the event that the University, the University-approved associated entity and/or the designee of the donor of an asset do not qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, the directors shall dispose of all of the assets of the Foundation exclusively for the purposes of the Foundation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious. charitable, educational, scientific or literary purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or to federal, state, or local governments to be used exclusively for public purposes. Any such assets not so disposed, shall be disposed of by the Superior Court in which the principal office of the Foundation is then located to one or more organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or to federal, state, or local governments to be used exclusively for public purposes.
- 10. Except as otherwise provided herein, these First Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation may be amended or repealed and new or amended articles of incorporation may be adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the directors then holding office at any regular or special meeting of the board of directors at which a quorum is present, provided that at least ten days' written notice is given of intention to alter, amend, repeal or adopt new articles of incorporation at such meeting.
