Financial Stability, Education, and Health. Agencies seeking funding through UWYC must meet eligibility standards, financial reporting requirements and demonstrate their ability to provide services that will change behavior and conditions. The Agency Allocation process is a cost-effective way to evaluate agency program applications and to ensure that the people who live and work in the community served by United Way of York County, SC are represented in the funding decisions. UWYC engages existing donors, business and community partners to convene and facilitate discussion and collaborations to address community issues. UWYC's expanded role in the community through Community Building initiatives and programs have increased the capacity of local agencies and organizations to address priority issues. 	Childcare Initiative UWYC participated in the United Way Association of South Carolina and Department of Social Services partnership to leverage additional federal funding to support local child care programs. The United Way of York County supports the following agencies who meet the criteria. Boys and Girls Club of York County, Upper Palmetto YMCA, the Youth Source, and the United Way's Community Impact T E A M S Program. The United Way of York County's board approved \$89,000 in support of these agencies which was used to gain an additional \$8,900 from the UWASC/DSS partnership for the above mentioned agencies.

The annual Community Investment Process (CIP) utilizes more than 35 local volunteers assigned to teams that review program applications, tour agencies and interview agency leadership to make informed decisions and funding recommendations. The AIC evaluates the funding proposals in relationship to local priorities and potential for creating lasting change with available funds for program distribution. The AIC's funding recommendation is acted upon and approved by UWYC's Board of Directors based on each year's projected campaign and revenue results. Agencies receive Allocation Investment Award notification letters and Memorandum of Agreement (MOA). As stated in the MOA, agencies must submit quarterly financial reports to maintain accountability and transparency to receive additional funds. Agencies failing to submit reports in a timely manner may face penalty or forfeit remaining.
