For the 2013-2014 school year Pace had an enrollment of 1,084 students in pre-first through 12th grades. The student teacher ratio was 9.1 with a class size on average of 15 students. Pace is recognized a "Leading Edge School" by the National Association of Independent Schools. The faculty average years of experience is 16, with an average of nine years at Pace Academy. Eighty percent of Upper School faculty holds graduate degrees, while 16 percent hold doctorates. One hundred percent of seniors were enrolled in at leading one advanced placement course, and the average SAT score of Pace students was 1300+. The graduating class of 2014 totaled 107 students who are attending different colleges and universities in the United States and Europe. The class of 2014 included three National Merit Scholars and two National Achievement Scholars During the year, Pace Academy continued construction of a new state of the art Upper School that will be available to teachers and students beginning in the 2014-2015 school year.	as a east 53
