Fundraising - United Arts actively seeks funding opportunities for arts and cultural organizations though annual fundraising campaigns. United Arts coordinates the largest collaborative fundraising campaign in support of arts and culture in Central Florida. Fourteen of the region's large arts and cultural organizations and four partner organizations actively participate in raising unrestricted operating support for the arts community. Donations designated to one or more of these collaborating arts and cultural organizations during the collaborative campaign, which runs from February 1 - April 30 annually, is matched at 15% by United Arts. In addition, donors may designate funds to any nonprofit arts and cultural organization during the Campaign. In FY14, United Arts raised over \$4.8 million for arts and culture, \$2.2 million of which was designated directly to regional art, science and history organizations. United Arts disbursed \$255,375 in matching funds in FY14 and expects to disburse over \$275,000 in matching funds in FY15. In May of 2013, United Arts acquired the Central Florida license for power2give from the Arts & Science Council in Charlotte, NC. Power2give is a crowd-funding giving portal dedicated to raising funds for nonprofit arts and cultural projects. In FY14, \$68,814 in project donations and matching support for donations was raised. Please note. United Arts operates in a fiscally conservative manner and prepares its budget on a forward-funding model, meaning funds raised during the annual campaign in one fiscal year are restricted to fund grants and operations in the following fiscal year. For this reason, in periods of declining economies where funds raised one year may be lower than the prior year, United Arts may show a deficit one year or a large net income the next. The forward-funding model ensures the agency has the committed funds on hand each year to fund the grants and operations proposed in its annual budget.

Grant Making - United Arts has three grant programs that support arts organizations and individual artists throughout the four-county region 1) Operating Support Grants (OSG) provide stabilizing operating support for the region's arts and cultural organizations with operating budgets in excess of \$600,000 In FY14, \$1,370,231 in funding was awarded to 14 organizations with 3 additional organizations receiving pass-through funding from government partners 2) Mini Grants - United Arts provided \$20,091 in Mini Grant funding to nonprofit arts and cultural organizations whose budget size and project scope do not fit the criteria of our Operating Support Grant program In FY14, United Arts received funds to add a subset to this grant program - Arts Engagement Grants (AEG) AEG support arts engagement programming for Orange County residents outside of a school environment. Grants will target after-school programming as well as programming for populations that do not have ready access to arts and cultural programming. In FY14, \$20,000 in program funding was awarded to 9 organizations. 3) Artist in Communities grants (AIC) support collaborative projects between an individual artist and the community that provides a meaningful impact on the community. In FY14, \$30,000 in funding was provided in support of 13 projects.

Arts Education Programming - United Arts facilitates curriculum-based K-12 arts education programming in the community through contracted services with local school districts and through our Operating Support grantees. United Arts' arts education initiatives expose students to music, theater, dance, film, ballet, and museums of art, history and science. In FY14, forty-six (46) diverse cultural organizations - all of them funded by United Arts - provided 697,164 curriculum-based arts education experiences for students in grades K-12. United Arts contracts with Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) to provide curriculum-based arts education services to OCPS students in K-12 (contract amount - \$412,500). In FY14, United Arts leveraged grant funds for arts education to encourage Lake, Osceola and Seminole counties to follow Orange County's lead in making K-12 arts education experiences a priority, resulting in an additional 16,690 arts education experiences for students in these counties. Statistics show that children that have arts credits in their curriculum have improved performance, are more likely to stay in school and are more likely to graduate. Engaging with the arts encourages critical thinking, resulting in more student engagement in the learning process and fewer discipline problems. This applies to all students regardless of ethnicity and socio-economic background. Arts experiences in our schools is a vital component of the education process. In June 2014, United Arts was awarded a \$300,000 creative industries workforce development grant. Through a collaboration with United Arts, Evans High School, Valencia College, University of Central Florida and Children's Home Society, this grant will provide technical training opportunities in back of house creative fields schools for high school students. Participating students can graduate high school with technical skill certifications or continue on for a degree Students will have opportunities to intern with art, science and history organizations as well as the

Other Programs - United Arts provides programming that raises awareness for the arts and provides a source of earned income for the arts and cultural organizations in the Central Florida region. Programs include. Orlando Arts Magazine - a bi-monthly publication (six issues published per year, pass-through readership rate of 450,000) that acts as a reference and guide to arts and cultural happenings in the Central Florida region and to the individuals who make it happen. The magazine is also offered as a donor premium for contributions of \$50 or more. OrlandoAtPlay com - an events website serving the seven-county Central Florida region. The site provides information on arts, science and history events as well as dining, nature activities, farmers markets and public arts. The site serves residents, visitors and the arts community as a comprehensive site to go to when you are looking for something to do, and is a central location to post information you want to share locally and nationally. In addition, site visitors can subscribe to a weekly newsletter providing information on events are coming up and providing information on discounted events. United ArtsCard - a donor premium for contributions of \$100 or more, the ArtsCard provides discounted admissions and classes for over 20 participating area art, science and history organizations. Grants management services - a fee-for-services program where United Arts lends its expertise in grants administration and management for other agencies wishing to provide grants to the arts and cultural community (in FY14, United Arts managed \$2,749,840 in grant funds for other agencies). Capacity building programs - United Arts facilitates workshops and capacity building opportunities to assist arts and cultural organizations with operational, fiscal and governance challenges

The events website is an arts and culture based site providing information on arts and cultural happenings throughout the seven-county Central Florida region - Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, Polk, Seminole and Volusia counties. Formerly called RedChairProject com, the events website was rebranded as OrlandoAtPlay com and relaunched on June 24, 2014, under the national Artsopolis platform. The site's offerings have also been expanded to include dining, farmers markets, nature experiences and public art in an effort to grow the site into a one-stop shop for anyone looking for something to do in their free time. The Community Database is a central database of donor and patron data. Individual data is kept private, but participating arts and cultural organizations can study aggregate data on donor and patron habits and work together to increase participation in the arts. In June 2014, United Arts was awarded a \$300,000 grant to fund creative industry workforce development in Evans High School in Orange County. Collaborating with Orange County Public Schools, Valencia College, University of Central Florida and Children's Home Society, the program will provide vocational training for students looking for careers in back of house creative arts such as set design, lighting, production and writing. The grant will fund programming in FY15 and FY16.
