Explanation

The transitional Development Program (TDP) provides case management, information and referral, and financial assistance to low income eligible clients seeking help to obtain or remain in housing. The program can assist clients with security deposits for rent or utilities, or with overdue or current rent, and overdue or current utility payments, depending on the clients need. A receptionist works with one of our partners, Manasota 211, which provides coordinated assessment services by screening clients for basic program eligibility. Clients that meet basic requirements of program eligibility are referred to the receptionist who makes an appointment for the clients with one of our three case managers. Two of our case managers handle funds for programs that provide short or long term intense case management for clients that usually need multiple levels of assistance. The third case manager handles funds for clients that need one time assistance to prevent homelessness. In 2013/2014 the TDP program saw a total of 1038 families who were applying for assistance. Of these households, 319 met program requirements and received financial help enabling them to prevent being homeless and to get into stable, permanent housing. The 319 households had 454 adults with 598 children. Each household was required to provide verification of their ability to maintain housing and also developed a personal household budget with the case manager. A homeless management information data base tracks clients and their progress and is overseen by our HMIS manager.

Explanation

The Open Door Resource Center is where men, women and children who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless can get basic needs met that the rest of us take for granted. Clients get access to hot showers, clean clothing, laundry services, restrooms, telephones, fax and computers. They can get hair cuts, get their mail delivered to the Open Door, get help with prescriptions, and other emergency services. One of the most critical services provided is assistance with obtaining birth certificates and legal identification. In order to access mainstream services that can help people achieve stability, clients must have these documents! We are proud to house a Job Connection office in the Open Door, manned by staff from our partner Goodwill Manasota. Clients have access to several staff with the expertise to assist them with obtaining and maintaining employment, the key to gaining housing stability! We also offer clients transportation assistance either with bus passes for those with appointments or jobs, or a once in a lifetime gift of a bicycle. In the past year, the Open Door served a record 2,203 new clients! There were 50,397 client visits and 294,295 services were provided to clients, along with their 1,090 children that accompanied them. There were 161 new clients that were veterans. Our ability to provide this wide variety of services is only possible because of the large number of volunteers who staff this program!

Explanation

The One Stop Clinic operated by Turning Points provides free medical and dental services to the under and uninsured people of Manatee County. One of the most critical needs in our county is access to dental care, and even people who have Medicaid or Medicare coverage have difficulty finding a provider who will see them. This is the population that we target, along with those who are homeless or have low income but cannot afford insurance. Our partnership with Lake Erie College of Medicine is critical as it enables us to provide primary care by utilizing fourth year medical students as providers, supervised by a physician. With the increased capacity of our medical clinic due to the expansion from three to eight examination rooms this past year, we are excited to be considering a range of options for expanding primary care to the under served population in our county. The dental clinic is staffed by two dentists, a dental assistant and hygienist, and volunteers and provides dental services daily to people who have no other access to dental care. In the past year there was a total of 6,513 client visits to our One Stop Clinic. There were 17,296 hours of service donated by professionals and front office staff, for a total value of \$1,392,484! We are also fortunate to have LECOM pharmacy students working with clients to help them access medication they may need by helping them sign up for prescription assistance programs that may be available for them.
