The income originally reported on the 2013 990-T was solely income derived from charitable gaming activities under Alaska Title 5 Chapter 15 charitable gaming program, namely pull tabs. The income was used specifically for the organizations exempt purposes. This return amends the prior filing by increasing the other deductions by 38,317 for expenses used for exempt purposes, resulting in an overpayment of \$5748 before consideration of penalties paid by the taxpayer. This income is also specifically excluded under the Revenue Act of 1978, Bingo and Charitable Gaming, IRS513(f)(2)(A) since under state law the gaming can only be conducted by nonprofit organizations.
