UWATX's work is focused on education, health, and financial stability - the building blocks of a good life. We strategically focus our work in the areas of education, financial stability, and health by bringing together issue area expertise and community partnerships.

SB6 facilitated the work of a large community coalition mobilized around the 2012-2015 School Readiness Action Plan for Travis County. Progress towards the identified community goals, strategies, and performance measures were monitored throughout the year and a year-end report was published.

SB6 began a 2nd year of implementation of a project designed to address a critical unmet community need for accessible, affordable early learning programs. The special project, called Play To Learn, combines parent education, early education, and technology tools to support over 200 low-income families with young children through a six-month, community-based program. In December 2013, the University of Texas released an evaluation of the project's first year which revealed very positive and meaningful outcomes for the participating children and parents.

The SB6 Center Project was launched in late 2013. This project provides coordinated services to 13 target child care centers serving low-income families. Based on the individual center needs, the project deployed classroom coaches, substitute teachers, professional development, direct mentoring, and mental health services for children with challenging behaviors.

United Way helps working poor families reduce expenses, increase income, and build savings. To achieve this, United Way leads and participates in local initiatives and connects low-income individuals to services such as safe and affordable financial services, free income tax preparation services, and financial education.

**Progress in 2013-14 -**

- Key financial stability programs were developed and delivered throughout the greater Austin area that included:

- United Way provided Learn Where You Earn financial education classes in the workplace for over 700 participants on topics including budgeting, credit, and debt management.

- United Way, in partnership with other area nonprofits and the City of Austin, supported free tax preparation services to over 19,000 low-income clients.

- United Way continued the training seminar, called the Financial Empowerment Boot Camp, to teach over 80 case managers and social service workers how to integrate financial education into their client services.

United Way for Greater Austin's Target Graduation program ensures high-risk youth are on the path to high school graduation by implementing broad, system-wide, interventions to positively impact individual student performance and the culture of learning.

Through deep and broad partnerships with nonprofits and schools, Middle School Matters strives to ensure students have a wide range of academic, health, and social services. Target Graduation supports student resilience, strengthens families and engages students with the surrounding community through high-quality programming.

- 3,082 interventions provided to students

- 284 out-of-school time professionals received training through the Youth Program Quality Initiative

The UWATX Navigation Center partners with 2-1-1 Texas through the Texas Health and Human Services Commission to help individuals navigate more than 60,000 services statewide.

**Progress in 2013-14 -**

- Answered more than 354,168 calls from a 10-county service area, with the largest number of calls from the Travis County and the Greater Austin Area (more than 40%). Additionally, more than 14,300 follow-up calls were made to previous callers to monitor customer service, quality of information given, and if needs were met.

- Provided referrals to a growing number of community-wide initiatives. These include community tax centers for free tax preparation services, summer food service programs that provide lunch to children in need during the summer, and back-to-school immunization programs.

- UWATX started partnering with Central Health in 2009 to make it easier for individuals to qualify for state and federal health care benefits like CHIP and MAP. In 2013, The UWATX Navigation Center expanded this partnership to serve as community focal point for Health Insurance Market place for local resources as well as contracted with local agencies to provide application assistance and enrollment for Travis County. 2-1-1 made close to 50,000 referrals to local resources to connect our community to health care coverages and received over 17,000 calls related to health care coverage such as, Marketplace, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, and Medical Access Program during this campaign.

- Program quality indicators are monitored regularly, and the UWATX Navigation Center achieved a 98% customer satisfaction score, with 99% of callers stating they would call again with future needs.
