FY 2014 LEGAL MATTERS

In Fiscal Year 2013-2014, attorneys at Liberty Institute worked on the following filed court cases and administrative proceedings:

ACLU v. New Hampshire (No. 2013-0455), New Hampshire Supreme Court; No. 2013-0455, New Hampshire District Court): We filed an amicus brief on behalf of the Association of Christian Schools International and coalition of New Hampshire Christian Schools concerning a lawsuit attacking the constitutionality of New Hampshire's tuition tax credit for parents who send their children to private schools.

American Atheists, Inc. v. Thompson (No. CIV-14-42-C), Western District of Oklahoma): Along with the Attorney General of Oklahoma, we are representing the State of Oklahoma in defending the Oklahoma Ten Commandments monument that sits on the Oklahoma Capitol grounds.

American Family Association, Inc. v. Sebelius (No. 1:13-CV-00032-SA-DAS, Northern District Court of Mississippi, Aberdeen Division): We represented the American Family Association in a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of the HHS Mandate requiring it (and other ministries) to provide insurance coverage, which includes abortion-inducing drugs.

American Humanists Association v. Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission (No. 8:14-cv-550-DKC), District of Maryland): We are representing The American Legion (national, state and local) in this case challenging the constitutionality of the Bladensburg (MD) World War I Veterans Memorial.

American Humanist Association et al. v. Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District (No. MON-L-1317-14), Monmouth County, New Jersey): We represent The American Legion, The American Legion Department of New Jersey and The American Legion Matawan Post 176 defending the constitutionality of the Pledge of Allegiance.

City of Bellaire, Texas v. Bellaire Jewish Center (No. 0900405 01), Municipal Court of Bellaire, Texas): We represent a Jewish synagogue in case where the City sued the congregation because it claimed the synagogue was violating local ordinances.

Cornerstone Church v. Bayview, Texas (No. 1:14-cv-126), Southern District of Texas): On behalf of the Cornerstone Church by the Bay, its pastor Hamilton Musser, and Laguna Madre Christian Academy, we filed a lawsuit against the Town of Bayview, TX, for enacting an illegal zoning ordinance prohibiting the church and religious school from operating on its own property.

Doe v. Acton-Boxborough Regional School District (No. SJC-11317, Supreme Judicial Court for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts): We represent the American Legion in this case, in which atheists are attacking the phrase "Under God" in the Pledge of Allegiance under the Massachusetts Constitution.

Does v. Jackson City School (No. 2:13-CV-00112-ALM-EPD, Southern District Court of Ohio): We represented the Jackson City Schools in a lawsuit filed by the ACLU and Freedom From Religion Foundation seeking to remove a portrait of Jesus from a school building.

The Episcopal Diocese of Ft. Worth v. The Episcopal Church (No. 11-0265, Supreme Court of Texas): We filed an amicus brief at the Texas Supreme Court in this church dispute defending the principles of the church autonomy doctrine.

Eschliman, v. Shaw Media (EEOC, Iowa): We are representing the former editor-in-chief of the Newton Daily News, Bob Eschliman, who was terminated for comments he made on his personal blog about Scripture and the institution of marriage.

Freedom From Religion Foundation v. Lew (No. 14-1152), 7th Circuit): We filed an amicus brief seeking a reversal of a lower court decision declaring unconstitutional the parsonage tax exemption.

Freedom From Religion Foundation v.
