Olympia Family Theater's mission is to offer accessible children's theater and programs that entertain and educate while stimulating dialogue and personal growth for young people, their families, and the wider community. In the 2013/2014 season, Olympia Family theater presented five main stage plays: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe, Lyle the Crocodile, The House at Pooh Corner, Orphan Train, and Three Tales with Eight Tails. Each play was performed at least four times a week for three weeks. Over the course of 71 performances, Olympia Family Theater entertained over 4400 audience members. 55 tickets (\$770 value) were donated as part of our Complimentary Tickets Program to underserved communities and 58 tickets (\$1024 value) were given to other organizations for their fundraising efforts. Olympia Family Theater received \$18,750 in donated broadcast advertising for the productions. Part III, Line 29. As part of our mission to encourage personal growth, Olympia Family Theater offered thirteen educational and creative drama camps throughout the year to 178 youth. They experienced and participated in sound and movement workshops, monologues, scene work, and put on theater performances. \$563 in scholarships was provided for youth in-need to attend camps. 44 youth took afterschool theater classes and performed in all-youth productions of Snow White, Pinocchio, and Beauty and the Beast. In addition, Olympia Family Theater's "On the Move" program brought short productions of Just So Stories, The Snow Queen and Ancient Super Heroes to 8 elementary schools and two libraries, reaching almost 3800 students. From September 2013 through June 2014, daytime interactive shows for all ages were performed once or twice monthly at the Olympia Family Theater space, entertaining over 1000 youth and parents, caregivers, and teachers. 21 children 18 months to 7 years explored movement and dance and were introduced to the theatrical arts through "OFTeenies" classes. Part IV Olympia Family Theater's Key Employees changed in spring 2014. The Managing Director resigned effective June 30, 2014, and the Board of Directors decided to hire an Organizational and Marketing Manager. The Organizational and Marketing Manager reports to the
