The U.S. Department using and Urban Development (HUD) requires communities receiving federal funding to have a local system which they refer to as Homeless Management nation System (HMIS). In El Paso County, we call this our Client Management System (CMS). It provides the required reporting tool for 16 agencies and 90 arms, and covers several entitlement programs. Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Program (CoC), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG), Supportive less for Veterans with Families (SSVF), and Veterans Administration Supportive Housing (VASH) CMS implementation presents the community with an attunity to re-examine how homeless services are provided, to make informed decisions and to develop appropriate action steps. CMS also allows community holders to build new alliances, strengthen services, meet consumer needs in a more streamlined manner and obtain information to guide future planning.
