(PPP) is a nationally recognized, non-profit technical and direct service provider based in both Pima and Maricopa Counties, Arizona and providing services in Arizona and across the U.S. and in American Samoa and the Republic of the Marshall Islands. The PPP provides a comprehensive array of clinical and technical services to meet the needs of youths and families throughout Arizona, the U.S., and the U.S. territories and jurisdictions. The agency's central goal is to help foster conditions for positive change by providing a range of services to individuals, community groups, agencies, and institutions.
