The University has also adopted the Policy for Financial Conflict of Interest Disclosure and Management for Investigators in Externally Sponsored Programs in compliance with US Department of Health and Human Services regulations (42 CFR Part 50, Subpart F) and the financial conflict of interest policies of the National Science Foundation. Finally, the Office of Finance and Business Affairs, through the Office of the Controller, reviews carefully all proposed business transactions, expenditures, and requests for reimbursements to determine compliance with University policies, including those relating to conflict of interest.</p> |
